JOB SUMMARY

Hope High School Online has an immediate opening for a Special Education teacher for the 2020-2021 school year. The position entails writing and implementing Individual Education Plans (IEP), facilitating Multidisciplinary Team Meetings (MET) and collaborating with the school psychologist to write the MET, and monitoring and supporting students as they work in online classes.
